Food Pantries and Kitchens

- All Saints Soup Kitchen & Food Pantry <https://www.ccsem.org/allsaints/>
 - The food pantry is open on Mondays and Thursdays 1pm-3pm and the soup kitchen is open on Wednesdays 12pm-1:30pm. They provide boxed, canned, packaged, refrigerated, and frozen foods. A photo identification and proof of address is required.
- Food Gatherers Community Kitchen
 - Located at 312 W Huron St, Ann Arbor, MI 48103. Hours are M-F 12pm-1pm and 5:30pm-6:30 pm, Weekend 3-4pm. Contact them at 734) 996-3052

 - The soup kitchen is open 7 days a week from 9am – 5pm.
- The W Pantry and Thrift Shop <https://thew.wayne.edu>
 - The pantry is open Wednesday – Friday from 2pm – 7pm and on Saturdays from 9am – 12pm. These resources are for Wayne State students, faculty, and staff members, and a current OneCard is required.

NORTHERN MICHIGAN RESOURCES

- The Manna Food Project <https://www.mannafoodproject.org>
 - The food pantry's hours are Tuesday 9am-12pm and the 2nd & 4th Thursdays of the month at 2pm-5pm. To receive resources, they only require name, address, and household size.



WESTERN/CENTRAL MICHIGAN

- The Food Pantry at Immanuel Lutheran Church <https://www.immanueljackson.org/food-pantry>
 - The hours are every Saturday from 9:30am-11:30 am. A valid identification is required. They provide bakery, meat, grocery items, canned vegetables, fruits, breakfast items and snacks.

 - They provide supplemental groceries every Tuesday from 5:30pm-7pm. Attendance to the Tuesday service is not required to receive assistance.

 - Open every Thursday from 9am-12pm. Visitors can receive assistance once per month.
